- II The Test Is A Maximum of 8 hours in Length.
- III If You Have Tested Before, You Must Wait 1 Full Year or Work 1500 Hours to Test to Higher Level.

The Test is in 2 Parts

1. A 100 Question Written Test Worth 20% of the Total Score.
2. A Skills Test Worth 80% of the Total Score.
 - a. Using Blueprint and Schedules, you will be asked to;
 - Cut in, Brush and Roll Walls Using Multiple Colors of Latex.
 - Apply Alkyd Materials by Brushing, Rolling, Conventional and Airless Spray.
 - Apply Clear Finishes to Wood.
 - All Paints, Masking Materials and Spray Equipment will be Provided.
 - A Wide Range of Roller Covers and Brushes will be Available.
